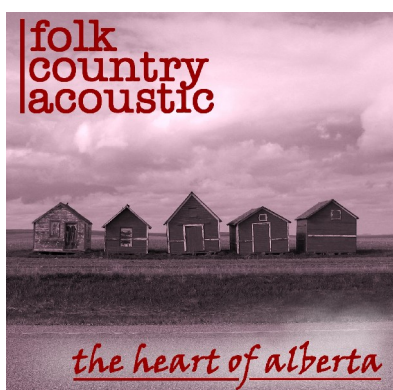
## P R E S S R E L E A S E
